

The Addison Board for the Abatement of Taxes met on Tuesday, April 23, 2024 at 6:30pm at the Addison Community Center to review taxes and penalties to be considered for abatement. Present were Jeff Kauffman SR, Peter Briggs, William Munoff, Alden Harwood, Cheri Waterman, Jennifer Barrett, Starr Phillips and Jane Spencer.

Jeff Kauffman opened the meeting. Alden Harwood, Delinquent Tax Collector, explained that the amounts that were showing due for Raymond Edwin \$1.70, Chuck & Sienna Euber \$0.84 and Philip & Robin Frasier \$1.75 were interest amounts that accrued because their payment was entered into the system a couple of days late. This was not to the fault of the tax payer.

The following owners and amounts owed listed below are trailers, all of whom Alden is unable to contact or are deceased. They include:

Any late notice mailed to the name and address are returned. These accounts are all at least 2 years old with no contact with the trailer owner.

Alden is asking to abate all of the mentioned amounts due.

Peter Briggs made a motion to abate all amounts due, on the named accounts for the following reasons: Taxes in which there was manifest error 24 VSA §1535(a)(4a): Taxes or charges of persons who have removed from the state. 24 VSA §1535(a)(2). Jennifer Barrett seconded the motion. All in favor.

Bill Munoff shared that the listers are doing their due diligence with the campground owners to collect the correct names and mailing addresses of the trailer owners.

This abatement hearing was adjourned following a BCA hearing.
